- Expert insights from project leaders

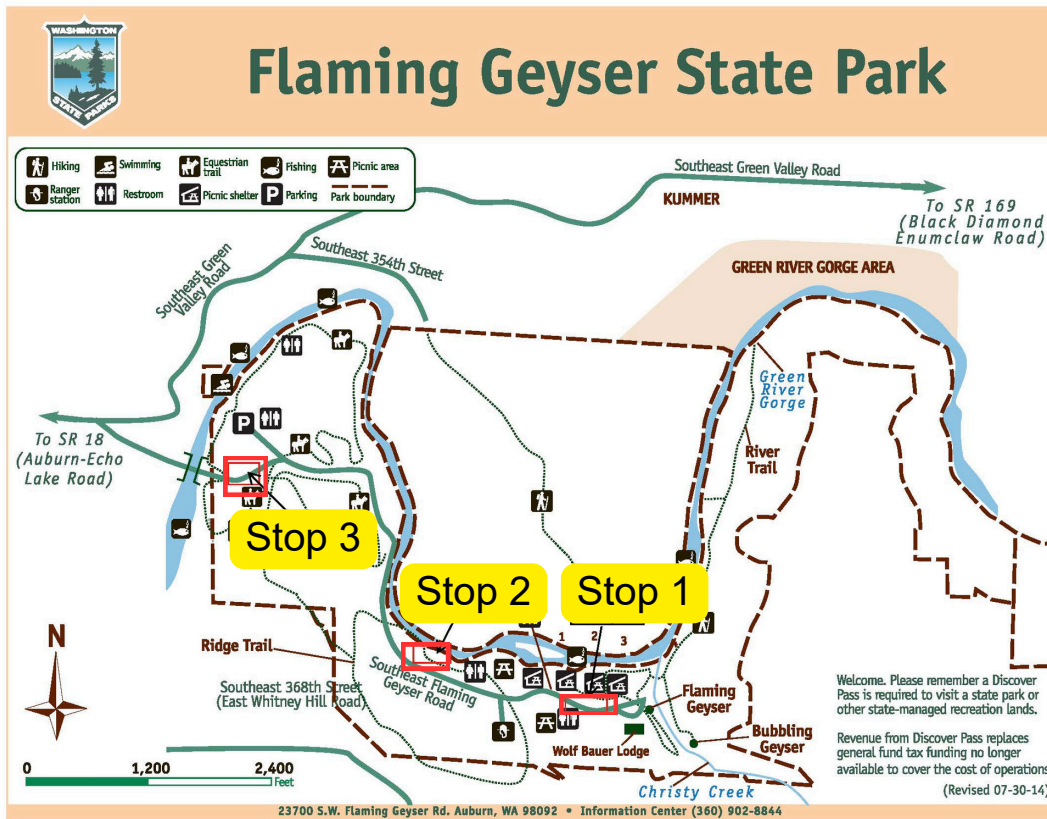

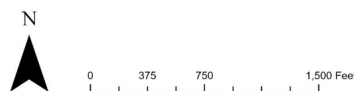
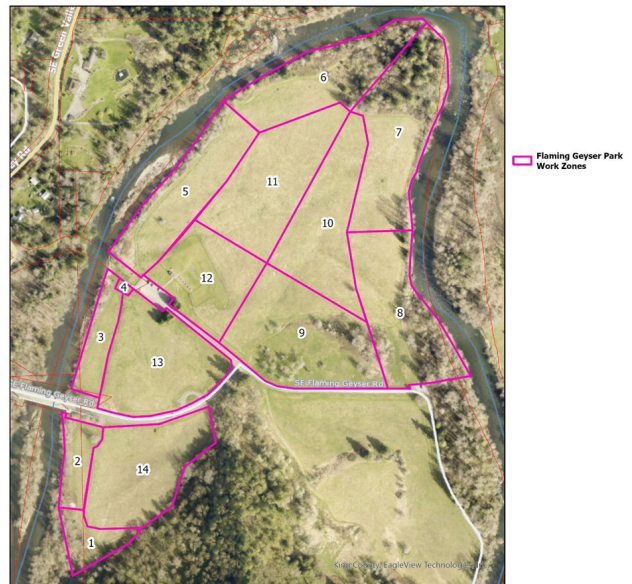
Stop 1 – Geologic Formations







- Bus/van transport to continue from Flaming Geyser State Park (Part 1) to White River Restoration (Part 2)
- Bus/van will return to Hotel Murano after the White River Restoration (Part 2) trip concludes




